**ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The Educational Therapy Institute provides professional level training for those interested in pursuing a career in educational therapy or enhancing their current level of professional development. The courses are open to qualified professionals who:

- Are interested in the application of educational therapy in educational or clinical settings and private practice;
- Meet the program requirements; and
- Are approved by the program coordinator.

The professional background of a candidate wishing to take these courses must include these requirements:

1. An advanced degree or equivalent in special education, learning disabilities, educational psychology, speech/language, or other related field
2. At least two years of teaching or related experience
3. Professional level proficiency in the following areas: listening and note-taking, reading comprehension, written expression and oral presentation
4. Evidence of completion of one course each in child development and teaching of reading

**REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS:**

1. Application form
2. \$50.00 non-refundable application fee
3. Official transcripts (or copies) from all institutions attended plus evidence of master's degree or equivalent
4. Current resume outlining past training, degrees, credentials held, and related work experience
5. A written statement of 100-200 words describing your educational career goals
6. Upon receipt of the above, the admissions committee will schedule an interview.
